



Boat Launch Permit Information

Thank you for purchasing an annual boat launch permit. The annual sticker must be attached to the left-hand side (the towing vehicle driver's side) of the boat trailer tongue being used to launch the boat or other watercraft. Any other location may result in a \$50.00 violation notice. If purchased online, this annual sticker will be mailed to you by office administration. Paper dash tags from self-registration forms at the boat landing and paper receipts from CivicRec purchases are only valid for 21 days from the date of purchase. If your pass is not received within 21 days of purchase, please contact the business office.

Please attach the sticker by its own adhesive. Taping or any other temporary attachment is not permitted. It is the responsibility of the owner to be sure that the annual sticker is clearly visible and maintained in legible condition at all times. If the original sticker becomes illegible, you may obtain a free replacement by removing the original sticker and bringing it with you to the Park Department office at 518 South 7th Avenue, Wausau WI 54401. The annual sticker and daily permit are not transferable or valid for anyone other than the original purchaser. On receipt of the annual sticker, dash tag is now void.

The boat landings that require a boat launch permit are County Parks - Big Eau Pleine Park, Bluegill Bay Park, DC Everest Park, Mission Lake Park and City of Wausau Parks - Gilbert Park, Memorial Park, Oak Island Park, Scholfield Park. Boat launch stickers are valid for only the calendar year printed on the sticker. Each boat trailer must have its own boat launch sticker or daily dash tag.

Please note: The Wausau and Marathon County Boat Launch sticker is not valid at any Village of Rothschild or City of Schofield boat landing. Assumption of Risk/Responsibility

The user hereby agrees to release, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the City of Wausau, Marathon County and the Wausau/Marathon County Parks Recreation and Forestry Department, their officials, officers, employees and agents from and against all judgments, damages, penalties, losses, costs, claims, expenses, suits, demands, debts, actions and/or causes of action of any type or nature whatsoever, including actual and reasonable attorney's fees, which may be sustained or to which they may be exposed, directly or indirectly, by reason of personal injury, death, property damage, or other liability, alleged or proven, arising from the activity, facility use or program described in this agreement.

City of Wausau, Marathon County Wausau/Marathon County Parks Recreation and Forestry Department does not waive, and specifically reserves, its rights to assert any and all affirmative defenses and limitations of liability as specifically set forth in Wisconsin Statutes, Chapter 893 and related statutes.

Survival

All express representations, indemnifications and limitations of liability included in this agreement will survive its completion or termination for any reason.

Revocation

The Wausau & Marathon County Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time, for any reason, if it is deemed by the Wausau & Marathon County Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department to be necessary to protect safety, life and property, or to be in the best interest of the City of Wausau and/or Marathon County.
